With her vast dance background, she has created award winning choreographies for her students at competitions, festivals, the BATD North American Scholarships and for the Canadian Championships. She has also had students pass their Associate & Member Teachers exams with the BATD.

Dawn has performed with many Celtic and Scottish groups including the Cape Breton Fiddle Orchestra, the Mudmen, Penetangore Pipe Band, Battlefield Band, and as an original member of Celtic Accent she performed with the 78<sup>th</sup> Fraser Highlanders in "Flame of Wrath".

Dawn has judged various competitions, championships and festivals across Canada and the United States at highland, national and choreography events, and conducted many workshops for highland dancers as well. She is a member of the British Association of Teachers of Dance and with ScotDance Canada, and is an Adjudicator with the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dance.
